Pair Firing Rules:	On Day 1 Competitors will be randomly assigned 2 to a target with efforts made to place like classifications together. In the event of an odd competitor the lowest classified competitor will shoot solo. In this instance they will be scored by another competitor from a different relay.
	On Day 2 Competitors will be paired based upon ranking from Day 1 Agg
	Competitors pair firing will have 45 seconds to fire after a score has been acknowledged. Competitors firing solo MUST wait 20 seconds after their shot before taking another shot(7 second delay + 6 second simulated competitor shot + simulated 7 second delay).
	Exceeding time limit will result in one warning. A second and any later violation will score a miss.
	Firing during 7 second delay or out of order will score a miss.
Awards:	Individual CIHPRS Class awards:
	There must be three or more entries in a class for one place award and the awarding of the High Class state champion award. Additional USHPSA place awards will be given for every additional 3 shooters in a class. Classes that do not have 3 competitors will be combined upwards to meet the minimum of 3 shooters.
	All F-Class will be combined for Class awards. Since there is a different number of shots fired between rifle types the winner will be determined by the highest percentage of Score/Shots Fired.
