Squadding:	Squadding will be randomly assigned by Classifications on the 1000yrd Line on Saturday September 25 th at approx. 8:00 A.M.
Classifications:	NRA or USHPSA Long Range Classifications will be used.
Divisions:	There will be 4 Divisions: High Power Prone(Any, Palma, Service) F-Open F-T/R F-Practical(see www.USHPSA.com for equipment requirement) 5 or more entries are required for awards in a division
Rifles:	Rifles are defined in rule 3.4 for Prone & F-Class and USHPSA for F-Practical. Rule 9.1 does not apply
Scoring:	All competitors shall perform scoring duties
Setup:	All competitors shall assist with set up and tear down of electronic targets.
Ammunition:	Rule 3.17, provided by the competitor
Targets:	LR and LR-FC will be used for all yard lines THIS MATCH WILL BE SHOT ON ELECTRONIC SILVER MOUNTAIN TARGETS. You are responsible for your own device.
Challenges	\$2.00 challenge fee. Refer to USHPSA.com for challenge rules
