- Rules:** All current NRA highpower and F-Class rules will apply.
- Eligibility:** Open to all.
- Entry Fees:** Two Day Regional Championship \$70/ Juniors \$30
Single Day Match \$40/ Juniors \$15
Preference given to those shooting the two day championship
- Entries:** **Register online at www.cihprs.org**
You may pay in person, cash only, in an envelope with your name, date and amount on it.
Entries are limited to 45 individuals. Match Director reserves the right to increase this.
Cancellations prior to the commencement of firing on Sat. May 21st, 2015 will be refunded in full.
No refunds will be made after firing commences on Sat. May 21st, 2015.
- Location:** Camp Atterbury is located SE of Indiana near the town of Edinburgh, off Highway 31.
- Accommodations:** On base housing is available at \$28 per night. Please call housing at 1-812-526-1128

- Squadding:** Squadding for individual matches will begin at 8:00 A.M. Saturday.
- Classification:** The NRA high power classification system will be used for all matches.
- Divisions:** There will be two divisions in all matches, NRA Match Rifle and NRA Service rifle.
- Categories:** The only special category will be Junior.
- Rifles:** NRA Match Rifle (Rule 3.3) or Service Rifle (Rule 3.1)
- Sights:** Metallic only (Rule 3.7a) match rifle, Service rifle metallic or optical in accordance with NRA rules.
Competitors electing to fire an Any Sight Match Rifle (Rule 3.3.2) will fire in a separate division and will not be combined with other competitors.
- Ammunition:** Rule 3.17, provided by the competitor.
- Targets:** SR at 200 yards, SR-3 at 300 yards, MR-1 at 600 yards.
- THIS MATCH WILL BE SHOT ON ELECTRONIC TARGETS**
- Sighting Shots:** Sighting Shots may be taken and scored when allowed in the match conditions. Sighting shots may be taken from any position describe in Rule 5. (except 5.13)
- Scoring & Pits:** All competitors shall perform scoring duties.
- Challenges:** A fee of \$2.00 will be collected in advance of each challenge.
- Additional:** The management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any competitor who endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the match. We also reserve the right to change the match program without notice if deemed advisable. Competitors and spectators assume all risk of accident and loss of property.

Course of Fire: .

Saturday, May 6th 2017 9:00 A.M.

Match 1: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, standing slow fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.12. Will be fired in an infiltration block time each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 2: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record sitting or kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.8 or 5.10

Match 3: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, prone, rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target. Rule 5.6

Match 4: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record prone, slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target, Rule 5.6. Will be fired in an infiltration block time each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 5 Day 1 Aggregate

Saturday, May 7th 2017 9:00 A.M.

Match 6: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, standing slow fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.12. Will be fired in an infiltration block time each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 7: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record sitting or kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target, Rule 5.8 or 5.10

Match 8: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, prone, rapid fire, 300 yards, SR3 target. Rule 5.6

Match 9: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record prone, slow fire, 600 yards, MR1 target, Rule 5.6. Will be fired in an infiltration block time each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 10: Day 2 Aggregate

Match 11: Regional Championship Aggregate of Matches 5 and 10

Awards:

Individual NRA Class awards:

There must be five or more entries in a class for one place award and the awarding of the NRA High Class regional award. Additional NRA place awards will be given for every additional 5 shooters in a class. Classes that do not have 5 competitors will be combined upwards to meet the minimum of 5 shooters. These awards are superseded by the Regional Championship NRA awards.

Regional Championship NRA Awards: Match 11

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion

2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion

3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion

Regional Championship CIHRPS Category Awards:

The following Category Awards will be given: High Match and Service. These awards are independent of the NRA Class and Regional Awards.

CIHRPS Cash Awards: Individual cash awards will be paid out for each match winner for Saturday May 21st only, using the following format.

Match Winner: \$10

Category Winner: \$5 (must be 3 in a category)

1st place Class: \$5 (superseded by Match Winner, must be 3 in a class)

2nd place Class: \$3 (must be 5 in a class)

3rd place Class: \$1 (must be 6 in a class)
