NRA Registered Fullbore Prone and F-Class Matches
300/500/600

Dates: April 9th, May 7th, August 13th, September 10th

Location: Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Rules: Current NRA Fullbore Rifle Rules will apply

Eligibility: Open

Classification: NRA Fullbore classification will be used. If competitors do not have a Fullbore classification but have either a High Power and/or Long Range and/or Mid-Range prone classification, the higher classification will be used until competitor obtains a Fullbore classification. Competitors with no classification in any High power discipline will fire in a separate class if 5 or more compete. Otherwise unclassified competitors will be combined with the Master Class.

Divisions: Target Rifle or International Target Rifle

Fees: \$30.00 for CIHPRS members, \$40.00 for non-members

Entries: Pre-registration will be available via the website. Walk up registration will be conducted at the Parking lot across from range control for an extra \$10 fee starting at 8am. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

Match Schedule: Roll Call is at 8:30am at the 300 yard line on Range 6, Firing will commence at 9am

Match 1- 300yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 convertible sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 2- 500 yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 3- 600 yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 4- Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-3. To be eligible for aggregate awards and to have scores turned in competitors must fire in the same division for all matches and with the required sights.

Rifle: NRA IFP Rules 3.3.5 and 3.3.6

Sights: NRA IFP Rule 3.7a

Ammunition: must follow NRA IFP rule

3.17a-.308 cal with a bullet of 156gr or less or .223cal with a bullet of less than 81 gr.

3.17b- F-class any is permitted without danger to competitors or range personnel.

Target: MR-63 (63FC F-class) at 300yds, MR-65 (65FC F-Class) at 500 yds, MR1 (MR1FC F-class) at 600 yards. This match will be fired on electronic targets

Scoring: Competitors will score for other relays.

Challenges: A fee of \$1.00 will be charged in advance for each challenge.

Divisions: Target Rifle or International Target Rifle

Fees: \$30.00 for CIHPRS members, \$40.00 for non-members

Entries: Registration will be available via the website.

Match Schedule: Mandatory roll call at 8:30am. Match will start at approximately 9:00am.

Match 1- 600yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 convertible sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 2- 600 yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 3- 600 yds, slow fire, prone iron sight, 2 sighters and 20 shots fired in an infiltration block time, each shooter gets 25 minutes.

Match 4- Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-3. To be eligible for aggregate awards and to have scores turned in competitors must fire in the same division for all matches and with the required sights.

Rifle: NRA IFP Rules 3.3.5 and 3.3.6

Sights: NRA IFP Rule 3.7a

Ammunition: must follow NRA IFP rule

3.17a-.308 cal with a bullet of 156gr or less or .223cal with a bullet of less than 82gr.

3.17b- F-class any is permitted without danger to competitors or range personnel.

Target: MR-63 (63FC F-class) at 300yds, MR-65 (65FC F-Class) at 500 yds, MR1 (MR1FC F-class) at 600 yards. This match will be shot on electronic targets.

Scoring: Competitors will pull targets and score for other relays.

Challenges: A fee of \$1.00 will be charged in advance for each challenge.
